Staying Out

Getting into trouble with the law?
Want to avoid going down that track?
Been in prison and finding life on the outside surprisingly tough?

Struggling to find your way in the community and want a bit of extra help?

You may be feeling anxious, depressed or frustrated. You might be feeling overwhelmed about finding a place to live, sorting out Centrelink, looking for work or settling back into the community. You might just want someone to talk to or a bit of social interaction outside of your scene.

A StAMP mentor from your local community may be able to assist you with some of these things.

If this sounds like you, maybe a StAMP Mentor can help you if:

- You are over 18 years old;
and
- You live in or near Sydney's inner west
and
- You have been in jail
or
- you have been charged with recent offences



How can a Mentor help?

By providing practical support such as:

- going to appointments with you
- helping you deal with red tape, fill out forms etc
- helping you to find local groups and services
- helping you get into study or work
- hooking you up with social networks in the inner west
- being someone you can talk to regularly
