## Staying Out

Staying out of prison can be pretty hard. A lot of people don't want to go back but they find themselves in the same old situation.

You know the drill: money hassles, housing hassles, drugs and the same old scene.

Are you sick and tired of ending up in prison?

- Are you getting out in at least 12 weeks time?
- Do you want to stay out?
- Would you like some support?  
Ask your Welfare Officer about CRC's Transition and Support Programs.

## What can our Programs do?

CRC's Women's Support and Transition Workers can provide links and assistance with drug and alcohol issues, Centrelink, applying for accommodation, family and social relationships.

### **The Women's Support Program and Transition Project:**

- Provide pre and post release support
- Aims to help people stay out of prison
- Works with people for up to 12 weeks before they are released
- Works with people for up to 12 months after release

## Who can apply?

The Women's Transition Project and Support Program will give priority to those who:

- Have very little support on the outside
- Have at least 12 weeks to go before release
- Have (or have had) drug or alcohol problems
- Are at risk of homelessness
- Have a history of going in and out of prison
