

Alternative Travel to Correctional Centres (When CRC bus is booked out)

Junee:

Junee is located 45km southwest of Sydney and 40km from Wagga Wagga. If travelling by car after entering the town of Junee follow Broadway north to Park Lane. Turn left into Park Lane and follow this road for approx. 1km. The route to the centre is well sign posted and there is parking available.

The nearest railway station is Junee. There is a taxi service which operates from the railway station contact number 0427 920 670. Junee community transport operates each weekend – bookings essential contact 02 6924 4800 (9am-3pm Monday to Friday).

Lithgow & Bathurst:

Bathurst -

The Complex is approximately 3km west of the town Centre. Turn onto Brooke Moore Avenue from the Mitchell Highway.

Lithgow –

The nearest railway station is at Lithgow. A taxi ride from the station to the Centre is approximately 7 km. A bus service runs from outside the Post Office (which is situated on Main Street across the road from the railway station) to the Centre on visits days. A bus leaves the Centre at approximately 3.00 pm for the return journey to the railway station.

Cessnock:

From Sydney take the Cessnock turnoff on the F3 freeway and follow the signs to Cessnock. Turn right at the first set of lights into Vincent St and follow it to the end. Turn left at the lights into Wollombi Rd. Proceed through the small roundabout and take the next right into Mount View Rd (following the sign marked "Correctional Centre"). Take the third right into Nelson St and turn right into Lindsay St. Follow Lindsay St to the Centre.

From the New England Highway, travelling south from Singleton, turn off at Branxton and follow the signs to Cessnock. Stay on Allandale road until it ends and turn right onto Wollombi Rd. From there the directions are the same as for the route from Sydney.

From Maitland turn left at the roundabout near Maitland station on the New England Highway. Follow the signs to Cessnock through Kurri Kurri, Weston, Abermain and Neath continuing on the same road through to Cessnock. Pass through two sets of traffic lights and you are on Wollombi Rd. Follow the same directions as for the route from Sydney.

From the station an hourly bus service operates to Cessnock shopping Centre with a journey time of 45 minutes. Bus services also operate from Sydney and Newcastle. From the shopping Centre it is a half hour walk or five minute taxi ride to the Centre.

Goulburn:

The nearest railway station is Goulburn. A taxi ride from the station to the Centre is approximately 3 km.

Travelling from Sydney, turn right at the first set of lights on the way into Goulburn (Union Street). Take the first right (at the roundabout) and follow the road around to the correctional Centre for about 1km. There is ample parking outside the main boom gate.

There is no public bus service currently available to the Complex. Visitors are required to arrange their own transport to the Complex. A one way taxi fare to the Complex costs approximately \$14 on a Saturday and up to \$17 on a Sunday / Public Holiday.

St Heliers Correctional Complex is located approximately 6km from the Muswellbrook CBD. Travel north through Muswellbrook along the New England Highway, turn right into Sandy Creek Road and continue for approximately 2km. Take the first turn to the left. Follow the signs to the Complex. There is limited parking available at the Complex.

Oberon:

Follow the Great Western Highway past Katoomba. After about 28km you will come to a steep hill, just after the historic village of Hartley on your left. As you begin to climb, you will see a signpost to Oberon/Jenolan Caves. Turn left.

You are now on the road which leads to both Oberon and the Jenolan Caves. Follow this road for 24km after which you will see a turn-off to the right to Oberon. Take this turn.

You have now left the road to Jenolan Caves and are on the road leading to Oberon. Follow this road for 20km and you will see a turn-off to the left called Titania Road. At this junction there is a small green sign with yellow print showing "Correction Centre".

Take this turn-off to the left and follow this road for 4km. You will come to a T intersection. Turn left - do not be alarmed that you are again on a road to the Jenolan Caves. You will very soon leave it.

After 2km, you will come to a turn-off to the right directing you to Shooters Hill, Butter Factory Lane. At this junction there is another small green sign with yellow print showing "Correctional Centre". Take this turn to the right.

Follow this road for 23km. You will come to an intersection just veering to the left with signposts directing you to Yerranderie and Mt. Werong. Once again you will see the small green sign with yellow writing directing you to the correctional Centre.

Take this, veering to the left, and follow this road for 6km. (Drive carefully, as this is a rather rough gravel road and you may occasionally meet large logging trucks).

After 6km, you will come to a turn-off to the right with a signpost declaring "Oberon Correctional Centre". Turn to the right and follow this road for 1km until you reach the Correctional Centre.

There is one car park at the Centre with ample parking for visitors.
