\$15.00 return for adults (18 years and over)

** Please note: These are the times you are required to be at your pick up points. The bus may be late depending on the number of passengers getting on at various pick up points, and traffic. The bus will not wait for you if you are late.

Details of pick up points

1. **Central Station** – Bay 18 on Pitt St (opposite YHA).
2. **Parramatta** – Fitzwilliam Street, bus stop opposite taxi rank. (From train station, come out on Argyle St where local buses stop and walk through to Fitzwilliam).
3. **Hornsby** – Station St, bus stop near train station entrance on western side. Opposite small grassy area with war memorial monument.
4. **Tuggerah Shopping Centre** – Behind Westfield shops. Wait in the bus area off Tuggerah Drive East, outer edge of parking area opposite Greater Union.
5. **Maitland** – Railway St, bus stop outside railway station entrance.

We have a 30-minute refreshment stop each way where there are fast-food outlets, toilets and a place to stretch your legs

WARNING

- Smoking and the consumption of food and drink is prohibited on board our bus
- Remember, trafficking of illegal drugs is prohibited and may result in your arrest and subsequent prosecution and/or being banned from further prison visits
- Sniffer dogs are used at correctional centres and may board the bus on arrival
- Abusive language or behaviour will not be tolerated on the bus.
