Details of pick up points

1. **Central** - bay 18 on Pitt Street
2. **Strathfield** - Everton Rd, long distance coach stop
3. **Parramatta** –Fitzwilliam Street, long distance coach stop
4. **Liverpool** - Cnr Bigg & Moore St, long distance bus stop
5. **Tuggerah Shopping Centre** – out the back of the centre

We have a 30-minute refreshment stop each way where there are fast-food outlets, toilets and a place to stretch your legs
