Details of pick up points

1. • Central Station – ‘Bus Stop 18’ On Pitt Street, Opp Yha.
2. • Parramatta –Fitzwilliam Street- Bus Stop Opp Taxi Rank
3. • Hornsby – Railway Station Entrance On Western Side
4. • Tuggerah – Behind Westfields Shops. Wait In The Bus Area.
5. • Maitland – Station St Bus Stop Outside Railway Station Entrance.
