

The Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) Transition Program can help you while you're in custody and after release.



AOD Transition Program

Outreach Alcohol and Other Drugs Counselling

The Transitional AOD Project is an outreach service for anyone who is exiting or has previously been in custody.

It provides pre-release and outreach individual counselling for up to 12 months, focusing on drug and/or alcohol issues. The Transitional AOD Project works in a respectful, culturally appropriate manner. We listen to what our clients want to achieve and assist them in reaching those goals.

To be eligible for the project, clients must:

- Aged 18 years old or older
- Have a release date confirmed and set if eligible for parole
- Be currently in custody or has previously been in custody
- Voluntarily seeking AOD support
- Have a history of offending behavior linked directly or indirectly to AOD use
- Reside or intend to reside in upon release, Greater Metropolitan Sydney:
 Eastern Suburbs / Inner West / Northern Sydney / South Eastern Sydney /
 Sydney / South Western Sydney / Western Sydney
